

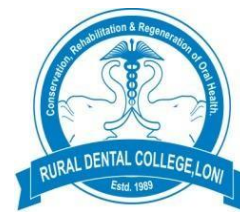

Dr. Birangane R S, Professor in the department of oral medicine and Radiology PDDU'S Dental College and Hospital Solapur, was resource person for the Guest Lecture. The no of participants in the lecture were 21. The Guest lecture was inaugurated by Dr Anita Munde head of the department of Oral Medicine and Radiology and Dr Birangane R S by floral tribute to the founder fathers of Institute Padmashree Dr Vitthalrao Vikhe Patil and Dr Balasaheb Vikhe Patil (Padmashree Awardee). He discussed about Saliva which has been studied extensively as a potential diagnostic tool over the last decade due to its ease and non-invasive accessibility along with its abundance of biomarkers, such as genetic material and proteins. Like serum, saliva also contains hormones, antibodies, growth factors, enzymes, microbes and their products. Many of these constituents enter saliva through blood via passive diffusion, active transport or extracellular ultra filtration. Therefore, saliva can be seen in many cases as a reflection of the physiological function of the body.
